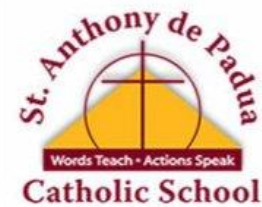
Treasurer report: No report at this meeting

#### Old Business/Committee Reports
