Prayer. Allison read a prayer

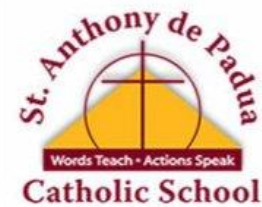
Treasurer report: No treasurer report this evening

New Business:

- I. Beautification Day: reminders went out to remind everyone about the beautification day coming up this Saturday.
