Dear St. Anthony Families,

Registration for 2018-19 is now open for our current families, using our website at www.stasb.org/registration. Please see the steps for registration on the back of this letter. You will also find tuition rates for the coming year accompanying this letter.

Please know that a great deal of time was spent working to determine tuition rates. It was very important to us that our families understand the process for determining tuition rates. The process for determining tuition involves the parish finance council, as well as our administrative staff here at the school. The actual cost to educate each student is \$6100 per year, which is partially subsidized by the parish. We try to make our best possible projections for expenditures that we can anticipate and then look at the contribution that the parish makes to the school in addition to the revenue received from tuition.

This year we also performed analysis of the tuition at St. Anthony, as it stands in comparison to other Catholic schools in the area. We made every effort to adjust tuition rates in a way that was financially prudent for the running of the school but also kept the costs passed along to our parents reasonable.

Please know that we are committed to making every effort for families to afford to send their children to our school. If you have questions or concerns, please contact me. Sending your child to a Catholic school is an investment. Our hope is that all of our families feel that they are engaged in a quality, faith-filled experience and that their investment in this partnership is paying great returns.

For families with an incoming Pre-K sibling for 2018-19, we are asking that you register as soon as possible, as we anticipate two full Pre-K classes for next year. The current family priority registration deadline for this year is January 26. At Open House on the 28th, we will begin accepting applications from new families. Priority for enrollment in any grade will be first-come, first served after the 26th.
