## Lunchroom Rules

Students are to behave in St. Anthony's lunch program in a manner consistent with good manners and Christian behavior. They are to eat and act in a courteous and responsible manner.

### Rules:

- Respect and obey the monitors by listening to and following their directions.
- WALK in the lunchroom without disturbing others.
- Once seated, remain seated until dismissed by the monitors.
- Eat politely; use proper table manners.
- Speak quietly to others at the same table.
- All food and drink is to be consumed within the lunchroom, not taken to the playground.
- Clean the eating area of all paper and trash and place this in the barrels provided before leaving.
- Dimmed lights require silence so that directions may be given.

### Consequences:

Infraction	Consequence	
1. Getting up from seat and moving around the room without permission	Verbal correction	Note to teacher for 3 repeat offenses in a month.
2. Leaving lunchroom without permission	Verbal correction	Note to teacher for 3 repeat offenses in a month.
3. Yelling	Verbal correction	Note to teacher for 3 repeat offenses in a month.
4. Not disposing of personal trash. Leaving trash on tables/floor or with others.	Return to clean area	Note to teacher for 3 repeat offenses in a month.
5. Touching, taking, or disturbing others' food. Sharing/trading food.	Note to teacher	
6. Not getting quiet when lights are dimmed	Note to teacher	
7. Running, pushing, shoving, rough-housing	Loss of recess & note to teacher	
8. Throwing balls, bouncing balls or using playground equipment in lunchroom	Loss of recess & note to teacher	
9. Throwing food or making an intentional mess with food	Loss of recess & detention	
10. Disrespect to lunchroom monitors (blatant)	Loss of recess & detention	
11. Fighting	Loss of recess & detention	

\*\*Notes to teachers will be dealt with using classroom conduct procedures.
